



Meteor Inkjet Responsible Minerals Sourcing Policy

Meteor Inkjet Ltd (Meteor) strives to be a sustainable and responsible organisation and to make a positive impact on people and the environment. As a manufacturer of electronics products, we incorporate components from many sources, and we require that materials used throughout our supply chain are sourced in responsible ways.

In 2010, the US Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act was passed concerning “conflict minerals” originating from the DRC (Democratic Republic of Congo) or adjoining countries. Although Meteor Inkjet Ltd is not a publicly traded US company, we work to support our customers who may need to conduct due diligence regarding the use of 3TG minerals (Tungsten, Tin, Tantalum, Gold) incorporated in their products. Additionally, as a socially responsible organisation, we intend to comply with the act, ensuring that 3TG minerals incorporated in our products are sourced from smelters who are registered with RMI (Responsible Minerals Initiative).

Meteor requires that its suppliers do not incorporate 3TG minerals from conflict affected and high-risk areas that directly or indirectly finance organisations employing violence, forced labour or other human rights abuses, as defined in Annex 2 of OECD Due Diligence Guidance. Meteor follows an IPC1755 compliant process to collect data on use of 3TG minerals using the CMRT (Conflict Minerals Reporting Template) provided by RMI.

Where concerns are identified with a particular supplier, as part of our due diligence, Meteor will investigate and may choose alternative suppliers that can meet these requirements.

Additionally, Meteor suppliers must comply with all national and international laws and regulations and maintain management systems to ensure that their upstream supply chain complies with the above.
